Workshop Details:

Join us for a continuation of our Conservation Easement Essentials (CE2) Workshop series. Building upon the foundation of the 2023 workshops, conservation partners will take a deeper dive into easement monitoring, stewardship, landowner perspectives, and easement misconceptions.

Day one will be classroom-style presentations beginning with an introduction to easements for newcomers, discussions on the pros and cons of being an easement landowner, and ending with a classroom activity designed to train participants in preparation for onsite easement monitoring.

Day two will apply the skills learned on day one with a trip to the field to complete a practice easement monitoring visit. We will wrap up the workshop with a discussion of monitoring findings and appropriate next steps for enforcement and stewardship.
